OVERVIEW

The OAR has received a request at short notice for protective airspace from the NSW National Parks and Wildlife Service due to an aerial baiting in remote areas of national parks. The operation is conducted from a helicopter below 3500FT and in daylight hours only.

PROPOSAL

To mitigate residual airspace risks posed by the bait deployment operation, two TDAs are proposed as below:

TDA North

Lateral Limits: 344319S 1500221E – 344518S 1501820E – 350618S 1501405E – 350423S 1495840E

Vertical Limits: SFC to 3500FT AMSL

Activation: NOTAM

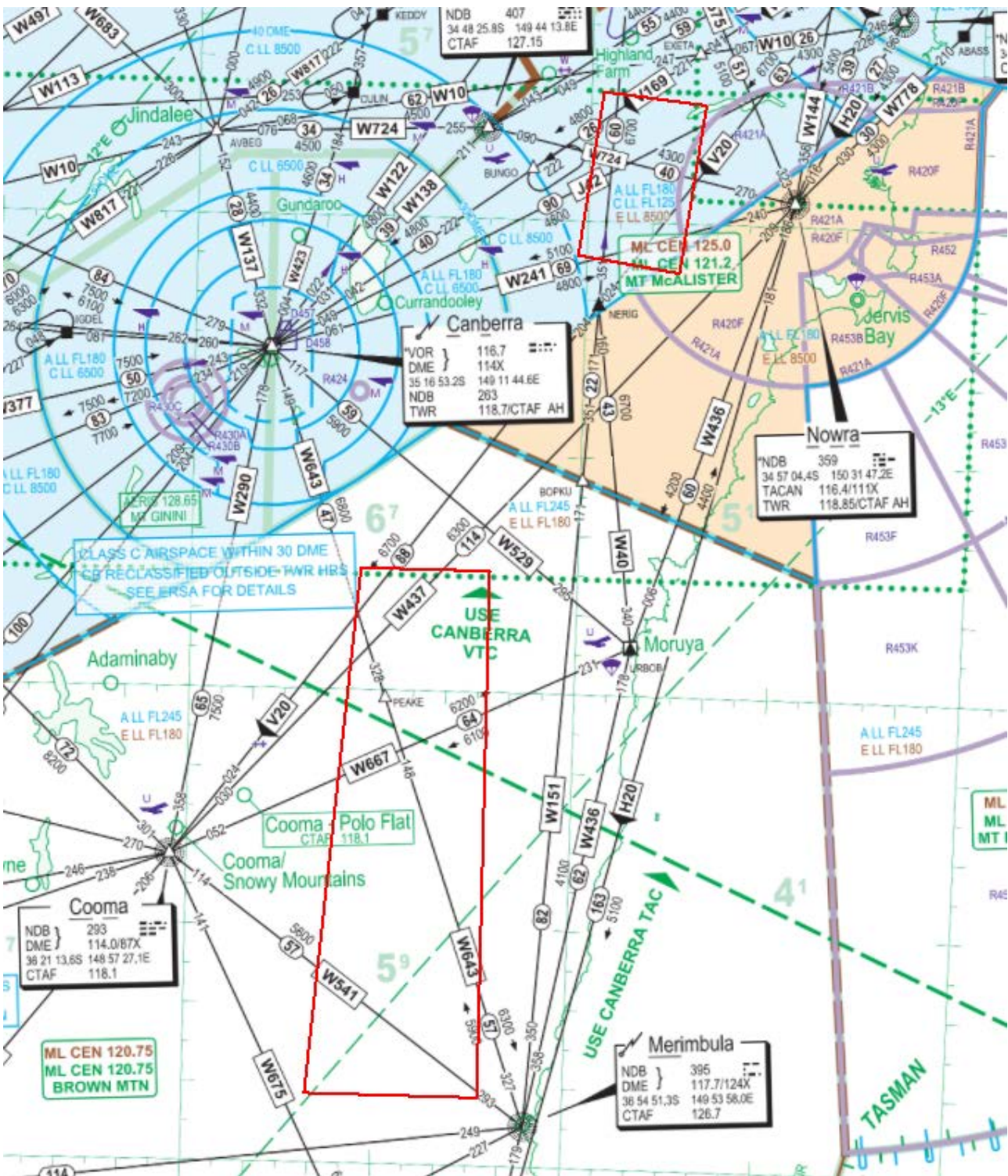
