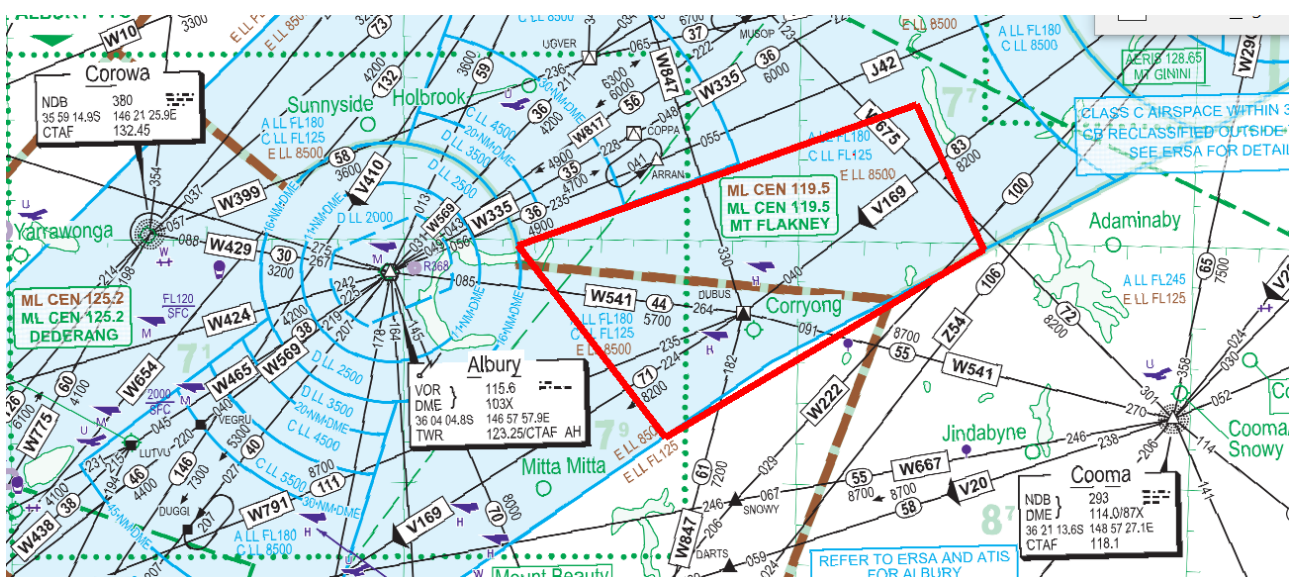
PROPOSAL

To warn other airspace users of the residual airspace risk posed by the activity it is proposed a TDA is established in Class G and E airspace. Every morning the organisers will advise of usage/non usage of the TDA to be active between 2000 and 0900 UTC.
