AIRSPACE RESTRICTIONS****1. INTRODUCTION**

- 1.1 The NSW Government will be sponsoring several activities in the airspace above Sydney Harbour on Australia Day, Tuesday 26 January 2021.
- 1.2 These activities include a number of aviation events that will affect operations in R405B and the uncontrolled airspace overlaying Sydney Harbour to the east of Sydney Harbour Bridge.

2. ACTIVITIES

- 2.1 Aviation activities over Sydney Harbour will include:

1200-1210	a flypast by two F-35A Lightning II aircraft;
1220-1240	an Australian and Ensign Flag towing operation by an RAN Seahawk helicopter;
1945-2000	a display by the Australian Army Red Beret parachute team over Sydney Cove / Circular Quay.

- 2.2 There will be a flypast of Parramatta Park by two F-35A Lightning II aircraft following the flypast over Sydney Harbour. These aircraft will transit to Parramatta through controlled airspace and there will be no additional airspace restrictions.

**3. AIRSPACE MANAGEMENT – TEMPORARY
RESTRICTED AREA ESTABLISHED**

- 3.1 A significant safety enhancement will be achieved by managing the uncontrolled airspace used for the F-35A activities, including R405B and the adjacent class G airspace to the north-east of R405B.

- 3.2 R405B will be deactivated and a Temporary Restricted Area (TRA) superimposed over the same volume of airspace, with an extension to the north-east.
- 3.3 The TRA extension to the north-east will comprise the area between Manly Harbour and the coast and will include the area between North and South Heads. It will not restrict access to the Victor 1 VFR coastal route.
- 3.4 There will be no airspace restrictions for the other aviation activities referred to in paras 2.1 and 2.2.
- 3.5 The lateral limits of the TRA, which overlays and extends R405B, are:

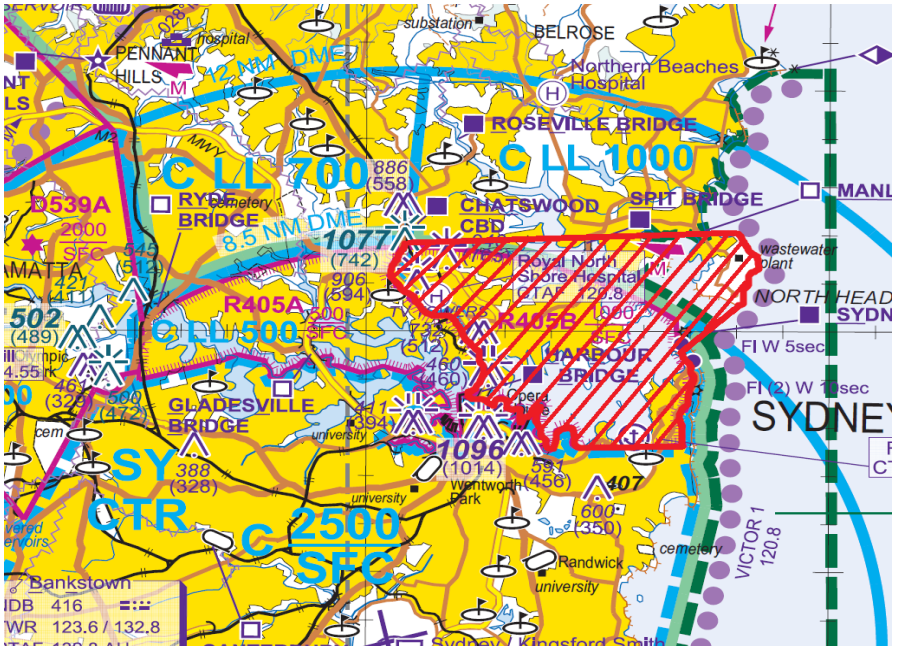

- 3.7 The controlling authority for the TRA will be Airservices Australia.
- 3.8 The TRA will be active between 1150 AEDT and 1220 AEDT to provide for the F-35A Lightning II aircraft flypast only. There will be no airspace restrictions for the other aviation activities referred to in paras 2.1 or 2.2.
- 3.9 Only aircraft pre-approved by the controlling authority will be permitted to enter the TRA during the period of activation.
- 3.10 Special arrangements will be in place for EMS and police helicopters.
