OVERVIEW

Rocketmine Australia will be conducting aerial survey in Regional Western Australia from December 2021. Remotely Piloted Aircraft Systems (RPAS) will be deployed Beyond Visual Line of Sight (BVLOS). RPAS operations will be conducted during daylight hours Monday through Sunday. In accordance with CASA approval, deconfliction requirements will be adhered to, including the use of NOTAMs, monitoring of the relevant aviation radio frequencies and the use of electronic conspicuity devices if/where required.

PROPOSAL

This information is provided as part of the Stakeholder Engagement Plan and to provide an opportunity for stakeholders to raise any safety concerns on the information provided. Specific stakeholder engagement will be conducted with those areas and operators more directly affected by this RPAS operation.
