OVERVIEW

Danger Area D108 is located approximately 1.5NM to the west of Mount Magnet aerodrome in Western Australia and overlaps D107. The contact for D108 has advised that mining operations in the pit have ceased and are not expected to resume.

PROPOSAL

As there is no residual airspace risk that warrants the continued existence of D108, it is proposed that it be disestablished with effect 17 June 2021 (the next available date for change). Below is the DAH entry and a pictorial representation of D108.
